Golden Age: Carol Simmler got her certificate. Dangles were given out to three dancers in the four corners area who have already received their certificates.

Vice president: No report.

5th Friday. Next 5th Friday is June 30, 2023. Montrose will check into hosting that. Just a reminder that the Fifth Friday dances are the responsibility of the Council as long as there is no Fifth Saturday the next day. The Fifth Saturday dances are the responsibility of the Callers Association.

Old Business:

Pat McBride moved that we move our bank account for the Peach Promenade to Bellco Credit Union where the Council's other banking accounts are, with Lynda Law, Jim Rush, Pat McBride as signers on the account. Cheryl Hickey seconded, Motion approved.

Proclamation Dance (Just keeping this in the old business so that we don't forget to work on it.) Elaine Bartholomew and JR Milner for Delta and Montrose and Pat McBride for GJ will be on the committee to work on the Proclamation dance and we'll get someone in Cortez. The committee can coordinate the proclamation signings so that they don't all fall at the same day/time. Cortez is encouraged to have a proclamation dance as well.

Hearing assisted devices. Discussion held. Duane Randol moved to back off the possibility of council purchasing hearing assisted equipment. Ida Schull seconded. Motion approved.

Policy and by laws are updated. Chuck Watkins sent the current version out to the bulletin email list. Pat McBride noted that in reviewing the bylaws and policy sheets, that there are lots of revisions needed to the policy sheets. A committee was formed consisting of Pat McBride, Jim Rush, Duane and Patty Randol and Abby Palmer, and Vicki Graffenberg. Pat McBride will talk to Chuck Watkins to see if he will serve as well. Pat McBride will set up a face to face meeting with the local participants and a zoom call for Duane and Patty Randol. Ideally, that meeting to discuss revisions will take place before the end of March as Abby will be gone most of April camping.

New Business:

From the last council meeting: Jim Rush brought up the need to set up a table and chair policy. Draft policy was sent out with the agenda. Discussion about donation and “timely” manner. Abby Palmer moved that we put a 5 day requirement to return tables and chairs to storage. Carol Watkins seconded. Motion carried. From Today: Discuss about donations for use and it was moved by Duane Randol that the donation would be voluntary for any individual requesting the use of the tables and chairs. Abby seconded. Motion carried. Discussion was also held on the 5 day return and it was decided by consensus that the 5 days was a guide line and that it could be changed on a case by case basis.

Mike Lee brought up that the dancers in Nucla/Naturita are interested in setting up a new club and join the council. Discussion held and suggestions made on how to set up a new club. Pat and Wanda McBride will get a copy of Promenading in the Rockies to Mike as that has some information about how to set up a club with some sample by-laws. Mike thanked everyone for the help.

Patty Randol moved to adjourn, Wanda McBride seconded.

We began 2023 with \$632 in the bank account. We paid \$273.58 to have 400 flyers printed and paid SEASDC \$40 for printing our flyer in their spring and summer bulletins, leaving \$318.42 in the account. The big news is that we have found a new home for the Peach Promenade. Lynda Law, Sue Schore, Naaman Moorehouse, Pat McBride, Chuck & Carol Watkins and Vicki Graffenberg and I formed a subcommittee to explore alternate venues for Peach. After much research, we agreed that the D51 Grand Mesa Middle School will be an outstanding venue to host the Promenade. Grand Mesa MS is located in Grand Junction just off Patterson Ave. (F Road) near the intersection with Business 70. The school is easy to get to, with plenty of well-lit parking. The large gymnasium with wood floor and ample cafeteria area located next to each other just inside the front door. The building feels bright and comfortable, is

very well lit and attractive. Many restaurants and a hotel are within a short driving distance. Just to remind everyone, Jerry Junck, our featured caller this year, will also be part of the team of local callers on Friday night. The Western Slope Caller & Cuers Association requested that we hire an outside caller to assist with the Friday night Peach program. We'll be using our featured caller on Friday nights going forward. Our featured 2024 caller will be Mike Seastrom, with cuing by John & Karen Herr. I am very pleased to announce that Joey Stafford has taken over the management of our Peach Facebook page.
