President's Corner

Two important proposals will be presented at November's Council meeting for discussion and voting. The first defines discretionary funds and details how they could be distributed back to our local clubs. The second presents multiple options for a dedicated Council website. I strongly encourage all dancers to attend this Council meeting, either in person or by Zoom (meeting info can be found in this Bulletin). Listen to the proposals' details, be part of the discussion, and then vote! All members of a club in good standing are eligible to vote. Don't grumble after the fact; vote and make a difference!

It's well-known amongst dancers that dancing keeps you moving and enthusiastic about life. Motion is lotion, as my physical therapist would say. And here's the proof:

The Golden Age Dancer program recognizes dancers who are still dancing at the age of 80. Twenty Golden Age certificates have been presented since Dec. 2020. I added up the number of years each of those dancers had danced at the time of presentation and the sum was 699 years! Divide that by 20 recipients and it's an average of 35 years of dancing per dancer! Oh. My. Gosh. The number of years ranged from a high of 70 years to a couple of newer ones at 4 years, and lots of in-betweens.

I am in awe. Think of the fun, laughter, fellowship and snacks (!) that each of those dancers has experienced and shared. 699 years of dancing. Just sit and think about the magnitude of that for a minute. Square dancers are some of the most spectacularly wonderful people I have the privilege to know.

And because dancers are so awesome, at the August meeting Council approved a Platinum Dancer certificate program. This is for people who are still round or square dancing at the age of 90. Again, sit and think about that. Who knew we'd need a recognition program for 90-year-old dancers? But I am absolutely thrilled that we do!

If you know someone who's still dancing at 90, please let me know and we'll get a certificate to them! They deserve recognition!

There are some fun special dances coming up -

- Nov. 18th, Mike Olivieri will be calling Chatfield's 35th Annual Turkey Tromp in Grand Junction. Come dance, work off the Thanksgiving calories ahead of time, and maybe win a free turkey!
- Next June 14th & 15th is the CO State Square Dance Festival in Pueblo. If you haven't registered yet, hop on-line and get 'er done. While you're there, pre-order a couple of '24K Gold Rush' tee-shirts, and help promote this festival.

As always, dance at your home club and in your neighboring towns as much as possible. Invite other dancers to go with you. You'll get to know the friendly dancers in other clubs and greatly increase your opportunities to dance and have fun. Remember - stay active!

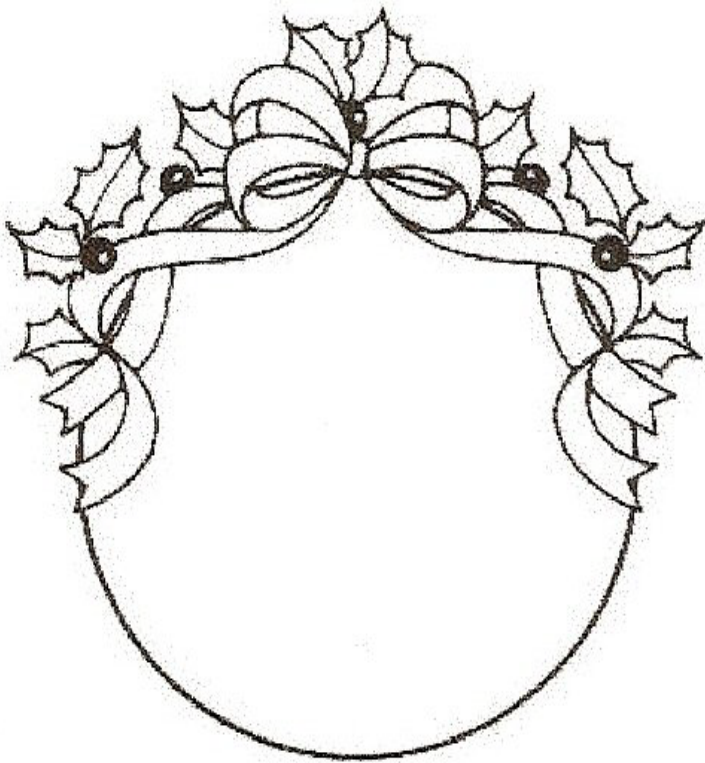

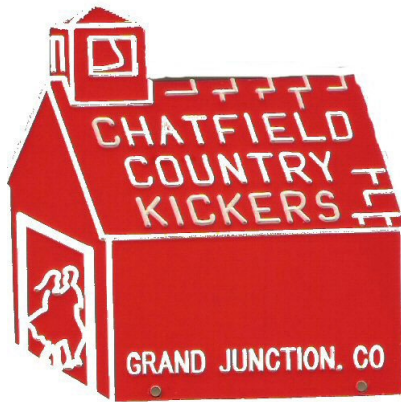

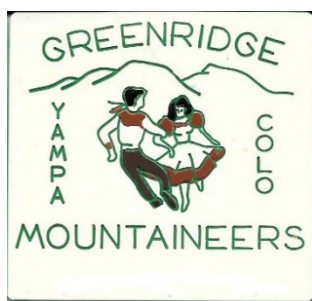

On November 25th, we will be Dark for Thanksgiving Weekend! Enjoy a Feast with Family and Friends!!

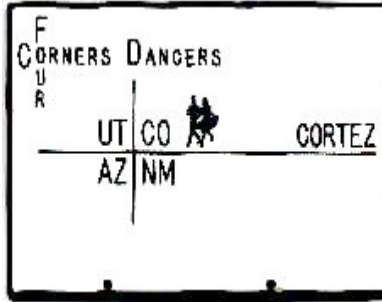
