Editor's Note: I received the following article from Richard Berry who asked to have it printed in the News Bulletin.

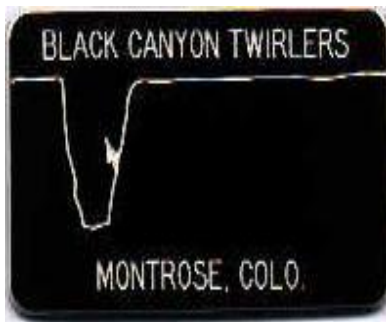
I had been having pain in my chest for the last couple of years & it seemed that I had undergone every test known to man to find out what it was , CT's MRI's , but they could not find anything. Ruth said all along it was my heart but the tests did not show that. Then on April 17th while in our exercise class I got to a point that I could not continue so I went into the room next door as the class was almost over anyway. Rayna the instructor came over to see about me & said that I should go to the hospital now to see if they could find anything while it was happening. They found an enzyme in the blood which is a sign of heart stress. I was then sent to Durango in an ambulance. Next day I went in to get stents put in but when they saw where the blockage was(not cholesterol, They called them "cabbages",) Stents would not work. So then I was flown to Colorado Springs for a triple by-pass. So after some days to get the blood pressure medication I'd been taking out of my system, on Monday April 22, I had the operation. I was down for a month or so but by the end of July I am back to calling & I would say now I'm 90-95%. The Doctors all say that my recovery is more that of a 50 year old than that of someone in their 80's. The Dr. that did the operation said that I did not have a heart attack; there was no damage to the heart function so I guess that I am blessed & so grateful. He also said that he put some kind of a clip on the heart that would prevent me from having a stroke.

So my rehab in Durango for 2 months twice a week & calling along with the honey does & up keep around here has been my life this year.

I hope that your year has been better than mine. I had a real surprise in Durango. My first night back we had 4 squares.

Well that is my story, I want to express my gratitude to everyone who sent cards & letters. Without every ones love & well wishes the outcome may have been much different.

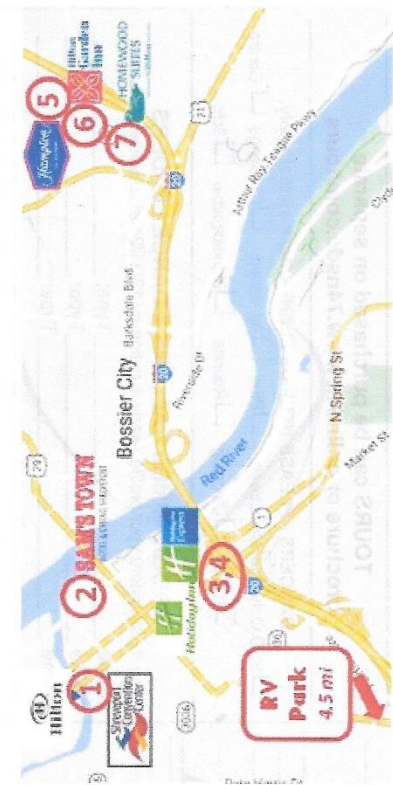
