Have a Happy Month of November and remember to Always Be Thankful!! Yellow Rocks!

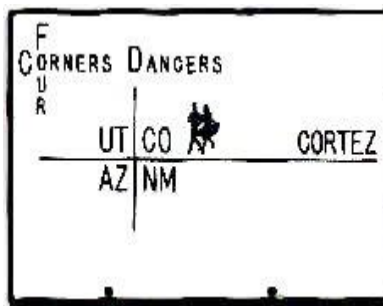

UPDATE



Dear Scooters,

Ralph, Cindy, Bill and I met with Ashley our t coordinator on Monday. At this meeting most of the discussion was new information on things we are offering that may be different **than** what they quoted us in the beginning. We want you to be aware of the changes. Here is what we have for now, please take a moment to read the whole message..

1. The RV Parking is in a different parking lot this year. The lot is directly across 20th Street from the University Center's lower parking lot. It will be a much shorter walk for you. We will be limited to 20 RV's, so get your reservation in early. The cost is still only \$25.00 per night. Remember it is dry camping, no services at all.

2. The meal plan has also changed.....Holmes dining hall which most of you will remember is where we have in the past enjoyed our all you can eat meals, will be closed the month of June 2026. They will be serving our all you can eat meals, with a wide variety of choices in the cafeteria dining room on the lower level of the University Center. Dinner Friday, Breakfast lunch and dinner on Saturday. \$60.00 per person for all 4 meals. The best deal in town!

3. For our Dorm dwellers, we will now be housed in the Hansen Willis Hall on the corner of 20th Street and 11th Avenue, cattycorner from the University Center. The cost remains at \$95.00 per person per day. There are two options: a single room (sleeps 1) with private bathroom and a two bedroom suite that sleeps 4 for \$95.00 per person.. We are limited to 7 single rooms and 17 doubles. If you need a room for just two, we are encouraging you to find a couple that you like to spend time with and share the 2 bedroom suite. That gives us the ability to accommodate more dancers in the dorms. A \$10.00 per person discount will be available if you fill your suite with 4. Please be aware, if you ordered a 2 bedroom suite for 2 you will automatically be moved to

a 2 bedroom for 4. Please consider adding 2 more people to your suite.

Note to our newest dancers. You may wonder why we have Thursday night on our lists.....traditionally there is a Trail Dance near by on Thursday that many will want to attend. It is not included in your festival registration but you may want to stay Thursday. Festival activities will begin in the early afternoon on Friday.

As the months go by, there could be other changes and additions. If that is the case, we will be communicating those changes to you soon after we learn of them.

Please use the revised pre-registration form to add on to your registration and/or share it with a dancer that **has not yet registered.** You are among the first 200 dancers to register and we are very grateful for your early registration. It really helps the committee members plan.
