Peach Promenade Committee Report

November 15, 2025

We had a lot of fun at this year's Peach, featuring a hilarious Buddy Weaver calling and Randy & Lorraine Pratt cuing. We inducted two couples from Cortez into the Hall of Fame: Duane & Patty Randol and Jerry & Ida Shull. A lot of folks left the silent auction with new treasures and a couple of dancers walked away from the 50/50 drawing with \$80 in their pockets. We even made a little money to put in the bank.

Looking at the Income & Expense report, our registration income of \$4,239.34 was down from the 2024 level of \$5,989, a drop of \$1,750. We had 103 dancers this year, compared to 147 dancers in 2024. At the same time, our venue rental rose from \$808.80 in 2024 to \$1,118.60 this year, a 38% increase.

We had a somewhat new expense this year, as well. For the past many years, Pat & Wanda McBride have generously provided lodging to our visiting callers and cuers. This year, family demands allowed them to “only” host the cuers, resulting in a budget item of “Caller lodging”. Over the years, the McBride’s generosity has effectively donated many thousands of dollars to Peach – we owe them a huge debt of “Thank Yous”.

Our net income was therefore decidedly down this year, from the 2024 recent peak of \$2,444.13 to this year’s revenue of \$688.79. Some arithmetic shows that \$607 of this year’s profit came from sales of dangles & badges, the silent auction and the 50/50 drawing. Many, many kudos to those hard-working volunteers who have lifted us up from merely breaking even with the dance.

While there were many who lent a hand with Peach, some volunteers deserve special recognition. Peach co-chair Lynda Law supervised the Peach layout and set-up details. Chuck & Carol Watkins staffed the dangle & badge desk. The 50/50 drawing was overseen by Stacey & Mike Lee. Wanda McBride made putting on a silent auction look easy. And our registration table hosts greeted everyone with a smile: Joe & Judy Chmiesleski, Abby Palmer & Walt Winne, Lynda Law and Sue Moon. Many thanks to one and all.

Looking forward, I expect to come before the next Council meeting with a request to examine our suggested dance donation structure for 2027.

TOO LATE: We had a dance on Saturday, November 22nd which was past the Bulletin deadline, so I'll tell you more next month!

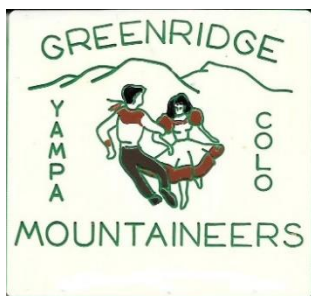
