Callerlab Mainstream and Plus Reorganization

Callerlab is now on the home stretch of its multi-year reorganization of the entry-level programs and the Plus program. The purpose was to have a single route to an easier entry-level New Mainstream Program and harder to get to the Plus program. Each program now has 50 calls. The New Mainstream Program looks almost identical to the previous Social Square Dance (SSD) Program while the new Plus Program had to bring down 10 of the easier Advanced calls to get to the 50 call goal after picking up the calls left over from the New Mainstream work. The attached new Plus list shows the source of the calls. The effective date for both programs is September 1, 2026.

Now that the call lists are known, the interesting question for clubs and dance organizations is how to best make the transition from the current programs. There are three transition cases depending on the current club program:

- SSD Clubs have the easiest transition to New Mainstream by dropping one call (Circle to a Line) and adding one call (Spin Top).
- Current Mainstream Clubs must decide to move to the New Mainstream by dropping 14 calls or move to the New Plus by adding 36 calls.
- Current Plus clubs will move to the New Plus by adding the additional 10 calls from the Advanced program.

SE Council Transition Plans

All the callers in the SE Council have jointly produced the following transition for the SSD Clubs. We will teach both Circle to a Line and Spin the Top in any new classes until September. We will immediately begin workshopping Spin the Top in any SSD dances that we call in the SE Council area.

SE Council has no Mainstream Clubs.

We are in discussions about the Plus transition. Three of the SSD Clubs have two or three Plus tips before the SSD dance. We will immediately begin using one of those tips to introduce the new Plus calls in alphabetical order to stay coordinated across clubs. Pikes Peak Plus in the Springs will also dedicate at least one workshop tip each dance to introducing the new Plus calls. We will review our progress in the summer with the possibility of having a three class Plus review in August or September.

The Old Mainstream Quandry

The current Mainstream clubs have three options:

- 1) Move to New Plus by adding 36 calls.
- 2) Move to New Mainstream by dropping 14 calls.
- 3) Join the Mainstream Resistance movement by staying with the Old Mainstream.

Moving to New Plus is really difficult to achieve. The 36 new calls would require about 12 lessons for the whole club. Since getting everyone through the lessons is unrealistic, there is a significant number of current members who would be left behind and lost. Let's also recognize that the Plus program has a different culture than Mainstream. While the social aspect is strong in both, the Plus culture is more fascinated with the "puzzle" part of dancing, including doing calls from a variety of arrangements and formations. The Plus culture may not be so appealing to all the Mainstream dancers who are being asked to make this transition.

Moving to New Mainstream is easy to successfully achieve. There are no new lessons and the program culture is similar. Some will mourn the loss of a few calls like WALK & DODGE and CLOVERLEAF. But, in reality, the loss of calls is not as great as one might think. Few will mourn the loss of SPIN CHAIN THRU or 8 CHAIN THRU as these calls are rarely done at Mainstream currently. Even though there are fewer calls at New Mainstream, there is more variety with the existing calls.

There is some sentiment among dancers in current Mainstream clubs to not bow down to "the man" (Callertab) and stay the course with Old Mainstream – the Mainstream Resistance. This might work well for a year, but let's look at the implications.

These clubs will, in time, get few visitors from the clubs who have transitioned. The New Mainstream clubs will not be dancing those 17 missing calls so those who knew them will get rusty. Their new classes will not be teaching them. Those dancers who moved to Plus are less likely to continue supporting the Mainstream clubs.

When these clubs continue to offer Old Mainstream classes, they will need to find a caller who is willing to teach them. When prospective students compare the cost and time of 25 lessons to the 15 lessons offered by the New Mainstream clubs, the choice is obvious. Recruiting new dancers will be even more difficult.

Regional, state, and national festivals will not offer Old Mainstream dancing. The Mainstream Resistance dancers will have no choice but to dance in the New Mainstream hall. The Mainstream Resistance clubs will become increasingly isolated over time.

When current Mainstream clubs have deliberations about their future, these considerations should be voiced to get a realistic vision of where the club is going. Transitioning to New Mainstream clearly offers the most successful outcome.

Club Responsibilities

Ultimately, each club must manage its own transition plan. However, coordination among clubs will help the dancers. Without this coordination, guests from other clubs may be surprised at new calls being danced and old calls not being danced during this transition period. An obvious role for the State and Regional Councils is to assist with that coordination.

Clubs will benefit from communicating with visiting callers on any changes to the advertised program during this transition period. In particular, clubs should communicate to callers if they expect new calls to be included or workshopped at the dance.

Managing this transition is additional work for both dance leadership and callers, but ignoring it will certainly not yield the best results for the dancers.

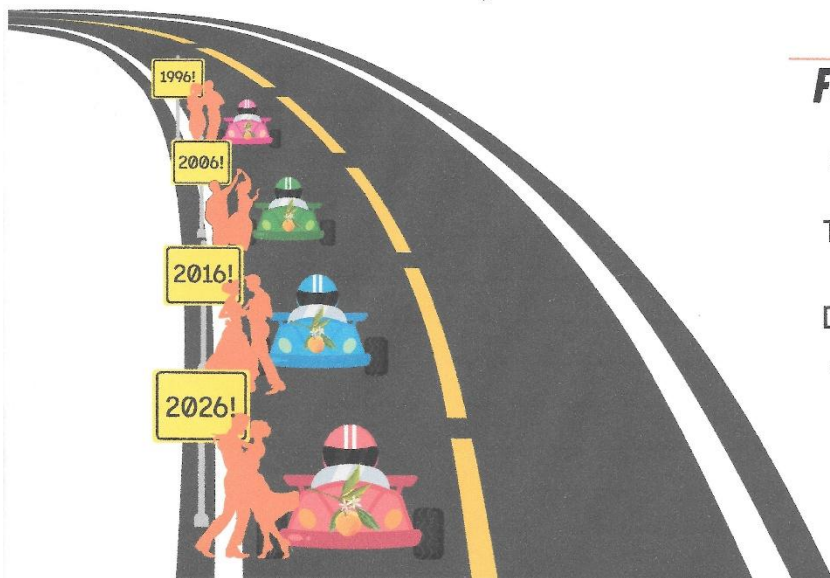
